Manuscript Sermons of John Wesley which Charles Wesley copied

During his voyage to Georgia, time spent there, and return trip to England Charles Wesley made longhand manuscript copies of several sermons his brother John had written and preached. Nine of these copies survive. In a few cases Charles's copy is the only surviving record of John's sermon.

On five of these copied sermons Charles added notations indicating that he had preached John's text, citing the day and place. These occasions are included in the "Register of Charles Wesley's Preaching" on this website. While these are not strictly "Charles Wesley sermons," they evidence his evolving practice of preaching, and the message he proclaimed.
