NOTE: His 1751 preaching tour convinced CW that he could not balance family responsibilities with such extended yearly excursions. From this point, he stayed closer to home, mainly going to London to provide oversight when JW was on the road. After CW's family moved to London in 1771, he made occasional similar trips back to Bristol. On a few occasions (like late 1756) JW persuaded CW to travel a bit more broadly, and some journal letters survive from these trips. Otherwise, our sources are limited largely to occasional letters that CW wrote to his family when he was away from home, and some scattered second-hand reporters like the Bristol steward.
